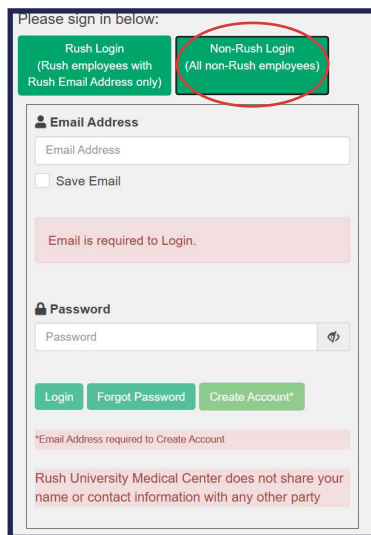


3. Please select accordingly:
Rush Employee: If you are a Rush employee, you will be able to use your Rush credentials to log in via Single Sign-On (SSO). Please select 'Rush Login (Rush employees with Rush Email Address only)'.
Non-Rush Employee: If you are not a Rush employee, please select 'Non-Rush Login (All non-Rush employees)'.



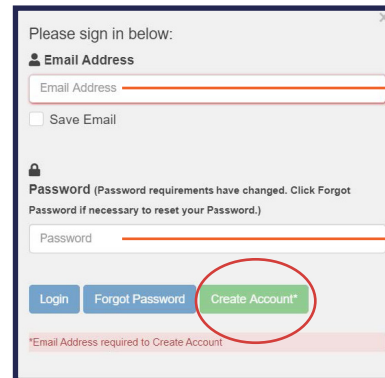
4. If you are a Rush employee and selected Single Sign-On (SSO) -OR- if you have used our system before and know your log-in information skip to **step 10**.

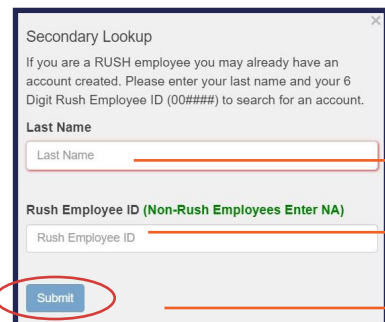

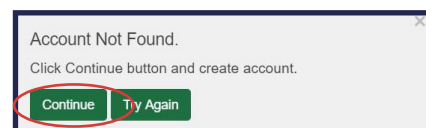

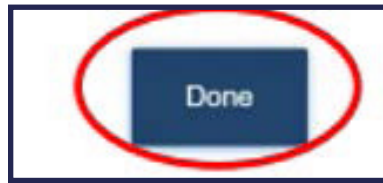
