Ensure Access to Medication: Join our Volunteer Pharmacy Team



The Role

Volunteer pharmacists work with technicians, students, and other volunteers to dispense prescriptions, and have the opportunity to counsel patients, consult with providers and assist with the coordination of care.

Volunteer pharmacy technicians, under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist, are responsible for intake, processing, and filling of prescriptions as well as inventory of medications and pharmacy supplies.



Schedule

- Must commit to at least two, four-hour shifts per month for one year
- Volunteers with weekday, daytime availability are especially needed
- Daytime, evening, and weekend shifts available



Benefits

- Ensure access to comprehensive, high-quality medical care for the low-income, uninsured
- Receive training and gain valuable experience working in a full-service, non-profit pharmacy
- Build relationships with likeminded peers in clinical and social services fields
