# Ensure Access to Medication: Join our Volunteer Pharmacy Team



## The Role

**Volunteer pharmacists** work with technicians, students, and other volunteers to dispense prescriptions, and have the opportunity to counsel patients, consult with providers and assist with the coordination of care.

**Volunteer pharmacy technicians**, under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist, are responsible for intake, processing, and filling of prescriptions as well as inventory of medications and pharmacy supplies.



## Schedule

- Must commit to at least two, four-hour shifts per month for one year
- Volunteers with weekday, daytime availability are especially needed
- Daytime, evening, and weekend shifts available



## Benefits

- Ensure access to comprehensive, high-quality medical care for the low-income, uninsured
- Receive training and gain valuable experience working in a full-service, non-profit pharmacy
- Build relationships with likeminded peers in clinical and social services fields
